



We have special news on Michigan advocacy for neuro-endocrine-immune diseases:

Michigan Rep. Thomas Hooker (R. Dist. 77) sponsored a resolution to increase medical education for neuro-endocrine-immune diseases (NEIDs). This includes fibromyalgia, myalgic encephalomyelitis / chronic fatigue syndrome and Lyme disease. The resolution also asks for a medical center of excellence for these complex chronic illnesses.

Good news! H.Res.372 is in the Michigan's Health Policy Committee for review. Because [H.Res.372](#) asks for specific action, there has to be a hearing before the committee decides to move the resolution to the House floor for a vote. If it is moved to the House floor and passes, the resolution will be as good as a bill.

Time to ask representatives for a hearing now!

Dear Chairwoman Haines,

Rep. Thomas Hooker sponsored and submitted House Resolution 372. It is now in the Health Policy Committee. We are writing to request a hearing on H.Res.372 so it can be moved to the House floor for vote.

The resolution is important because these conditions are more common than similarly disabling conditions, such as multiple sclerosis, AIDs and most cancers. A delay in diagnosis and in treatment affects individual productivity, disability rates, and Medicaid costs, as well as quality of life and long-term health outcomes. It is a drain on our economy. Creating a center of excellence in Michigan would greatly improve timely diagnosis and treatment for the thousands in Michigan who have the diseases. Because
